## **To be eligible for consideration papers should be received by 14 July 2010.**

Applicants will be notified by the end of July whether they have been successful. The selection panel will be a panel of your peers.

### **Important Information**

- Send as electronic file
- Abstracts must be author's own work
- Abstracts should consist of a maximum of 250 words of TEXT ONLY (tables, graphs and graphics should not be included at all)
- Research abstracts should be structured - (Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion)
- List name of presenting author FIRST
- Include all co-author's names and organisations
- Abstracts should contain sufficient data to represent the proposed presentation, to enable fair assessment
