## Partnership “type”

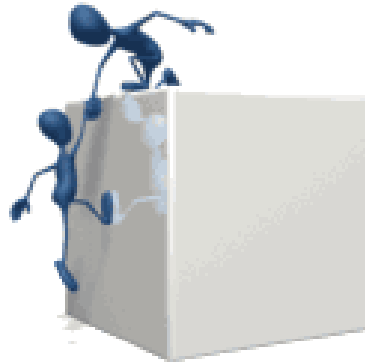
- Networking
